



The following beers are permanent fixtures of our tap list:

Golden Wheat Light

This carbonated house ale is light in colour, not in calorie. It is made with a blend of malted barley and wheat. Golden Wheat Light is served chilled and carbonated with a crisp, lightly hopped flavor. O.G. 1.042

Extra Special Bitter

This medium bodied pale ale, is a copper-coloured special bitter with spicy Cascade hops that has been carbonated to suit the American palette. O.G. 1.052

Best Bitter

A traditional British style cask-conditioned pale ale, naturally carbonated and served on our hand pump. This medium bodied house specialty has a fruity hop finish. O.G.1.050

In addition, to these three, we keep either a porter, brown ale or stout on at all times plus a seasonal addition. These can be found in the list below:

The Fairer Ales:

India Pale Ale

A bitter but balanced pale ale with a hefty dose of Fuggles and Cascade hops. Served the best way possible, on the hand pump. O.G.1.055

Northwest IPA

Our hoppiest beer ever, inspired by the robust beers of the Pacific Northwest. This IPA is about 5.2% abv and features Centennial hops and Cascade for the bittering hops, and a blend of Goldings and Cascade for the aroma. Served carbonated. O.G. 1.057

Session Ale

An easy drinking pale ale with a dry malty finish and flowery hop profile. It is designed for musicians who need to play an all night session, unimpeded by alcoholic fingers. O.G. 1.040

Golden Jubilee

This strong golden ale emphasizes malt on the palate. It is lightly hopped and served carbonated. O.G.1.062

Porters, Brown Ales and Stouts:

Mild

A light bodied brown ale with dark crystal malt and chocolate malt with Fuggles and Goldings hops. A perfect session pint. Served carbonated. O.G.1.042

Pheasant Plucker

A medium bodied, slightly bitter brown ale made with molasses and caramel malts. Pheasant Plucker is served cask-conditioned. O.G.1.052

Welsh Ale

A medium bodied malty brown ale with an aromatic addition of Goldings hops and an appealing slightly sweet finish. Served cask-conditioned. O.G.1.055

Highland Piper Scotch Ale

At 6.3%abv, this beer marries roasted malts and dark crystal malt to produce a warming, malty brew. Drink responsibly. It's a big one. Served cask-conditioned. O.G. 1.063

Dark Charger Ale

A medium bodied brown ale. This cask-conditioned ale is brewed with dark crystal and chocolate malts to give an attractive color and slightly bitter taste. O.G.1.057

Cromwell's Demise

Another of our big brews using molasses to develop a complex caramel flavor. This beer is served on the hand pump and is finished with Fuggles and Goldings hops. O.G.1.062

The Beer Formerly Known as Celebration (BFKC)

A big zesty winter ale made with three types of roasted barley and finished with Cascade hops. For some reason, another brewery didn't like the original name and had their lawyers tell us so. Served either cask-conditioned or carbonated. O.G.1.062

The Ship's Porter

A medium bodied ale with mild roasted flavour. This version of porter comes out of a pleasant afternoon at the Fuller's brewery in London. Served either cask-conditioned or carbonated. O.G.1.050

Randy's Panhead Porter

A muscular, American-style porter with a hefty roasted finish. Served carbonated. O.G.1.057

Black Death Stout

This robust stout registers 6% abv and is chock full of roasted malt. If you like big full-bodied beers, this one's for you. Served lightly carbonated. O.G.1.059

Irish Stout

A light bodied dry stout with a hint of Leprechaun. Served under nitrogen. O.G.1.042
